THE IMPERIAL Board of Telecommunications of Ethiopia has ordered a new international radio communications system, to be supplied by Marconi's and Standard Telephones and Cables Limited. The system, which will work from Addis Ababa, will provide radio telephone and telegraph communication with London, Nairobi and centres in the Middle East.

This Company will provide the complete radio receiving station. We will also be responsible for the engineering, supplying and installing of the complete aerial systems for the transmitting and receiving stations, and for supplying the independent sideband equipment.

A considerable quantity of ancillary equipment, including power units for the transmitting station, the receiving station and the Central Telegraph Office is also to be supplied, together with spares for the entire Marconi order.
